The Birmingham Central Synagogue welcomes visitors, in accordance with the biblical command to welcome all visitors and to show hospitality.

Whilst welcoming visitors, this policy also reflects the paramount need to protect the safety of our community and our visitors.

The administrator and security officers will act in a courteous manner at all times, whilst maintaining the site's security.

Booking Procedure

- All bookings must be made at least 21 days in advance, on-line via the Synagogue website: www.centralshul.com

Parking

- There is limited parking on the Synagogue forecourt. Coaches may stop outside the Synagogue when pupils/students arrive and depart, but are advised to park in a side street during the visit.

Dress and behaviour code

- All visitors are politely asked to respect the Synagogue's dress code.
- Males should wear head covering (which we can supply if needed).
- When visiting the Synagogue visitors are asked to dress respectfully and modestly.
- Visitors should ensure that mobile phones and electronic equipment are switched off.
